We have been involved in some many hands-on learning experiences to help us create and recognise equivalent fractions.

We created strips of paper to show how different fractions could be represented, helping us to create their equivalent fractions.

We also modelled equivalent fractions on Geoboards.

These are some of the equivalent fractions we discovered:

 $\frac{1}{2}$  (one half) =  $\frac{2}{4}$  (two quarters) and  $\frac{1}{4}$  (one quarter) =  $\frac{2}{8}$  (two eighths)  $\frac{2}{6}$  (two sixths) =  $\frac{1}{3}$  (one third) and  $\frac{1}{6}$  (one sixth) =  $\frac{2}{12}$  (two twelfths)

There is a large amount of jumpers without names in the lost property. They have been placed in the library for students to check.


Please make sure your child's names are on all jumpers, lunch boxes and drink bottles, so they can be returned to the students.


